COACHES CHARTER - 2017

INTRODUCTION

The Boys club has been existence since 1964. Whilst we have many experienced coaches, new members, who are unfamiliar with the custom and practice of the Club, may find this document useful. It may also serve to remind older hands. If in doubt ask a Committee member.

START OF SEASON

- Attend AGM;
- Help out at Registration Sunday;
- Attend Allocations Night contact all players allocated to your team;
- Ensure your PVG registration is completed (the Club will assist with this);
- Stock take of strips for your team;
- Pre-season training session(s). Issuing of strips
- Familiarise with playing equipment (how to set up the goals safely)
- Familiarise with the Competition Rules, Disciplinary Code and Child Protection Policy.

PLAYING DAYS

- Kick-off 7.00pm; come early 6.15, 6.30 at latest; Matches on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays
- Ensure you have a list of contact numbers for your players in case of emergency. Note any medical conditions;
- take goals from containers supervise erection of goals and corner flags; warm up,
 reverse at end of game;
- Pre-match talk, starting line up; fair play, equal playing time; dismantle goals and return to container – neatly;
- Act as assistant referee to 'run the line'.
- Post match man of the match name given to referee. (player from opposite team).
- Ensure the pitches are left litter free

END OF SEASON

- Gather strips in. Check condition.
- Attend the medal ceremony (if you are lucky enough to win a trophy).
